WHEN TO VISIT – Most schools visit from April to July.
Knowsley Safari Park is open ALL YEAR, so you can also
visit during the Autumn term or even Winter; the animals
are still here!

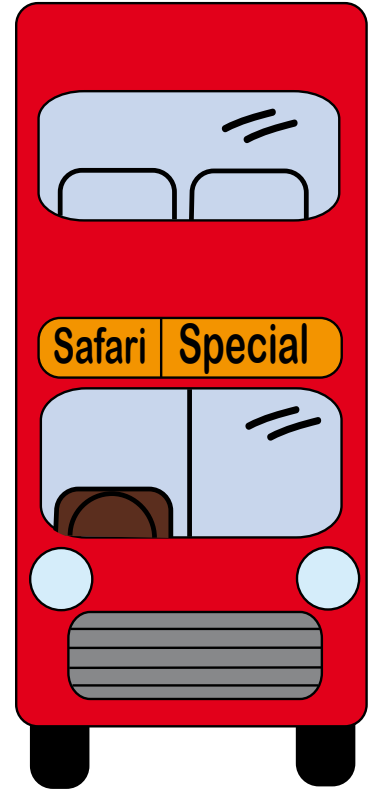
OPENING TIMES – Summer 10.00 am Winter 10.30 am

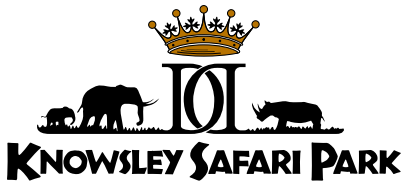
PAYMENT – Please pay on arrival. The school trip special offer entry fee
applies to children and adults, there is an extra charge for
SAFARI SCHOOL sessions. Please phone or look on our web
site for current prices.

TOILETS – Toilet facilities are located at the entrance to the Safari Drive
and next to the Oasis Restaurant after the Safari Drive.

PACK LUNCHES – If the weather is kind, you may picnic on any grassy
area outside of the Safari Drive area. If it rains please
go to the Sea Lion Show arena 30 minutes before your
show is due to start (12.00 or 1.00) you may eat your
lunches there and you are ready for the 12.30 or 1.30
show.

Coaches must take the vehicle friendly route around the outside of the baboon
enclosure due to H&S measures.

HELPFUL HINTS

Yet more helpful hints for you to gain the most out of your visit.

SAFARI DRIVE – It takes approximately one hour to go round our 5 mile Safari. So please bear this in mind when planning your day trip.

RISK ASSESSMENT – there is a **FREE** downloadable Guide to Risk Assessment on our website School Visits page, teachers resources section.

Knowsley Safari Park is inspected regularly in order to be licensed under the Zoo Act. As long as you follow the Safari Park safety regulations, your visit will be a safe one.

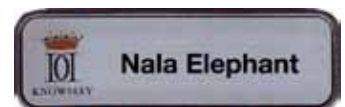
You are advised to wash hands after touching any of the animals at the Lake Farm and after a Safari School session.

All handleable animals are closely supervised by a member of staff and are used to being handled.

INSURANCE – Knowsley Safari Park is covered for public liability. A copy of the cover note is available on request to the education department.

FIRST AID – The Safari Park has a designated area near the amusement park and a number of trained first aiders. However, bringing your own first aid kit would be helpful.

LOST CHILDREN – Children should be advised to report to a member of staff in the unlikely event of getting separated from their party. Knowsley Safari Park Staff wear a uniform plus a silver badge showing our logo and their name.

Special Safety regulations

- Please read and strictly obey all signs and especially observe the signs instructing you to keep the doors and windows locked when entering the Monkey Jungle and Lion Reserve.
- It is the driver's responsibility that nobody leaves the vehicle while in the Safari Drive.
- It is the driver's responsibility to take all reasonable precautions for the care of the vehicle, including driving on, if any large animal approaches the vehicle.
- If the vehicle breaks down, do not get out, sound the horn and wait for a patrol vehicle to come to you.
- Dogs and other pets are not allowed in the Safari Park.
- Children must be kept under close supervision by adults and the doors of vehicles containing children should be kept locked while in the Safari Park.
